LOOK TWICE

for motorcyclists at intersections, highway entrances, and when turning or changing lanes. The size of motorcycles makes them hard to see, and they can get lost in blind spots.

FOLLOW SAFELY

Use the "Two-second Rule." Pick a point on the road and make sure the motorcycle passes it at least two seconds before you do. Increase this distance in inclement weather.

SHARE the ROAD

Give motorcyclists their full lane when you pass them. Don't re-enter their lane until you can see them at a safe distance behind you in your rearview mirror.
